5/23 Erasmus+ staff mobility grants: Call for applications May 2023

Møtebehandling

Advisor at the International Office Ida Charlotte Jakobsen gave a short introduction to the case.

The priority for this call is changed from the SEA-EU to all mobility because SEA-EU will have their own allocation from now on.

There was made some comments and asked some questions in the meeting.

1. The Business school asked if there was to be an information meeting before the next call.
 - Ida Charlotte Jakobsen: Yes, an invitation will be published before easter
2. The question on how the different faculties prioritize their mobilities was raised:
 - FBA: Prioritize the people who want to spread the knowledge gained at the mobility. How is the effect spread out throughout the faculty?
 - FSV: Prioritize BIPs and the most strategic applicants
 - HHN: The prioritization is discussed in the local international committee and with the head of office
 - FLU: In the last call all applicants to the SEA-EU were prioritized.

There was made a comment from Ida Charlotte Jakobsen that prioritizing should be done prior to the application deadline. As the responsible person for staff mobility in Erasmus+ she is in dialogue with the faculties on this. More information to come to the faculties later on.

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14/23: SEA-EU status report meeting 2/23

Project manager for the SEA-EU Tove Holm gave a summary of the tasks Nord University is involved in. Please see the attached file.

There was recently a partner visit in Bodø from SEA-EU partner University of Cádiz. The visit was from March 15th – 17th where our partner met both Rector Hanne Solheim Hansen, the Prorectors and members of Faculty. There has been meetings about joint degrees and the challenges ahead, to identify the barriers and what we change to get around them. We need to be more ambitious and attractive. SEA-EU to be in front of new things

Tove Holm encouraged the faculties to find their relevant faculty at each SEA-EU institution and start communication with some of them to develop cooperation. It is important that Nord University recruits student ambassadors and look into the development of BIPs with the SEA-EU partners.

The committee sees the need to develop information about Nord to SEA-EU partners and students within the SEA-EU. The international office will look into this with project manager Tove Holm.

Elena Popova from the international office asked if there is a plan for how PhD mobility between the partners is going to take place? Tove Holm replied that this was discussed in the visit and that they are looking into the possibilities for this. A new website for the SEA-EU is under construction and will be launched in October. Information about the possibilities (for PhD) and an overview of research groups will be made available there. For now, all questions regarding this can be addressed to Tove Holm.

Vice Dean of Education at the Faculty of Education and Arts, Vegar Sellæg, made a comment that it is hard to get a handle on everything (within SEA-EU), and that it is important to work from a strategic plan for involvement. He raised the question on how to involve the core academic staff at each faculty and that some processes to this day has been a bit top-down. Its proven challenging to involve the core staff and that the project has a risk of differentiation on involvement based on how each faculty is organized. The University needs a management idea to “force” involvement. Its not possible to only rely on internal motivation.

Sandra Wiik from the Business School said that there is a lot of staff that are interested in being involved with the SEA-EU but some are finding it difficult to engage due to lack of information on who to contact or how to get involved.

Tove Holm and the Director of Academic Affairs Anne Ringen Pedersen has been working on a list of names that are responsible for tasks and work packages within the SEA.EU. When the list is complete there will be an open meeting with all personnel in charge where staff can listen in and ask questions. The plan is to systemize these kinds of meetings and disseminate what is going on within the alliance and how to get involved.

Student representative Anna Viktoria Bjørsvik will present from the student council SEA-EU at the next meeting in June.

15/23: Competitiveness

Mari Anna Friedrich from the International office and head of the committee Levi Gårseth-Nesbakk gave a short introduction to the case.

Prorector Levi Gårseth-Nesbakk emphasized the huge opportunity Nord University has through SEA-EU to improve internationalization. Nord University has a huge ambition for this project, but the success of the SEA-EU relies on the faculties development of more courses and programs in English, as well as teaching more of the current courses in English.

We already have fierce competition on the international and national education arena and now that tuitions fees will be implemented for students with citizenships outside the EU/EEA and Swiss area, this competition is only getting tougher. If we want to be a competitive and recognized University, we need to be better at internationalization.

There was made some comments from the members in the meeting.

The Faculty of Education and Arts are looking into starting two new international bachelor programs, and two new master programs in English. At bachelor level the faculty is working towards creating one program within theater, and one within sport science. At the master level they are hoping to create a master in music and one in sport science. Vegar Sellæg raised the question on how to get numbers from the admissions office on how many international students to expect when creating these international programs. This is a difficult question to answer, and the head of the committee Prorector Levi Gårseth-Nesbakk will discuss it with the Director of Academic Affairs Anne Ringen Pedersen.

The Faculty of Biosciences and Aquaculture is currently working at looking at past application numbers and where the students are coming from. From those EU countries with most students, they can intensify the recruitment from these countries. Measure from where applicants outside EU are coming from and where to put in effort – who is likely to be able to pay, and look at recruitment from these countries. Will have an overview of numbers soon, and will share with the other faculties.

The Business school is looking at SEA-EU partners to see which Bachelor programs that can qualify to the Business schools master programs. This work will be complete in April, and will be presented in the management group and will be further discussed. Sandra Wiik is involved due to double degrees, and it is talked about having two different admissions for international students.

The Faculty of Social Sciences are looking into summer schools and has already sent an initiative to the education committee.

Head of the committee Prorector Levi Gårseth-Nesbakk informs about the growth in alumni which Nord University has experienced after giving alumni a bigger priority. Alumni are good

ambassadors to promote Nord, and it is good if we can include the international students in the alumni.

Head of the International Office Monica Brobak stresses the importance of Nord University to work better and more strategic with marketing and recruitment of international students, and that funding is needed to be able to meet the needs for better communication. The importance of recruitment from bachelor level to master level was also lifted by the committee members. How can we make it more attractive to do the master at Nord University rather than at other institutions?

16/23: Revision of mandate and constitution of the International Committee

Ida Charlotte Jakobsen, secretary of the international committee gave a short introduction to the case.

There was some discussion in the meeting where the committee members stressed the importance of the mandate to contain:

- In point two “research” should be implemented
- The mandate needs to give more empowerment to the committee
- How to create enforcement?
The mandate needs to make it more attractive to be a member of the committee
- Important that the mandate clearly differentiate the international committee from the research committee or the education committee.

The members also discussed the constitution of members in the committee and it was discussed if the constitution should be a combination of lecturers, researchers, study advisors, academic staff, administrative staff, PhD students, bachelor students and master students.

By May 5th all faculties are asked to:

1. Comment, make changes with specific phrasings to the mandate before May 5th
2. Comment and make changes to constitution of the International committee before May 5th. Important that this contains specific suggestions for type of composition in the committee.

The secretaries of the committee will send out the final review of the mandate and constitution to the Faculties by 26th of May. The new mandate and constitution will be decided on in the June meeting and sent to Rector for approval. The Committee shall operate under the new mandate and constitution from Autumn 2023.

17/23: Application for Erasmus+ funding, European mobility (KA131)

Erasmus+ coordinator, Elena Popova, from the international office gave a short orientation about the number of mobilities Nord University has applied for.

There were no comments from the members in the committee.

There will be a follow up case in the June meeting with detailed information on the dropout rate for students and staff, and why they drop out to be able to share experiences and look at measurements to decrease the number of drop outs.

18/23: Status application KA171 - Erasmus International Credit Mobility

Ida Charlotte Jakobsen from the international office gave a short introduction to the case.

Nord University applied for four different mobility projects within the Erasmus+ Global Mobility key action. Elena Popova gave a brief orientation on the applications and the projects from previous years.

It was shortly discussed if Nord University should set criteria for applying for KA171. Ida Charlotte Jakobsen will present a routine description linked to the application for KA171 at a later committee meeting.

19/23: Numbers Outgoing Mobility - Follow up

Kai- Martin Johnsen from the international office gave a brief introduction to the case.

Nord University are experiencing an increase in numbers of applicants for student mobility.

One of the committee members asked about the reasons for the drop in numbers at the Business School and at the Faculty of Education and Arts. The Business School has experienced a drop in numbers due to the pandemic, and the Faculty of Education and Arts see that they need to increase the recruitment in study programs where few students today go abroad.

The committee will discuss looking into measurements to avoid the big drop out between application and traveling abroad.

20/23: Status applications for incoming exchange autumn 23 and spring 24

Adryani Landum at the international office gave a short introduction to the case. The committee is very positive towards the progression of the pilot project on “Nominasjonsweb” and “Søknadsweb”.

There will be given a update on the number of applicants for Exchange at the meeting in June.

21/23: International Week 2023, status meeting 2/23

Mari Anna gave a status update on the ongoing work with International week. The date is set to October 23 – 27. The goal for this years week is to build a platform and make the week known in the organization. The SEA-EU is to establish staff weeks which will be included in the International week later on.

To be able to succeed with this year’s international week its crucial that the international coordinators at faculty involves the leadership at faculty level and that the faculties develop relevant programs for their staff during this week.

The working group will have an invitation for all staff ready before easter. This will be distributed to the faculty coordinators.

The working group will also work on the invites and program for the students after easter.

Prorector Levi Gårseth-Nesbakk will help send information to the Vice Deans.

It was commented that it is important to make sure all events are recorded and digitally available for all students and staff at all campuses.

A new update will be given in the June meeting.

22/23: Southern African – Nordic Centre (SANORD)

Ida Charlotte Jakobsen presented the case.
SANORD offers scholarship for incoming students.

One issue with some of the institution within the SANORD network is that they are on the list of “Student at Risk”. All faculties should have this in mind when they discuss SANORD.

All faculties are encouraged to discuss the opportunities within SANORD at their local international committees and give an update in the June meeting.

23/23: Evaluation staff seminar internationalization

Ida Charlotte Jakobsen gave a summary of the evaluation of staff seminar which was held in February. The topics this year were opt-out, tuition fees, and joint- degrees.

26 participants attended the staff seminar.

A working group has been decided, and time and date for next year's seminar should be agreed upon in the June meeting.

24/23: Protocols from the local international committee meeting 2/23

For this meeting there was only one protocol made available. Its important that the faculties plan their meetings in the local international committee accordingly with the dates for the central international committee.

Before the June meeting all faculties are asked to discuss and identify opportunities within the SEA-EU and the most promising university partners. All faculties are asked to present an overview of this in the first meeting of the next academic year.

Sammendrag

INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE MANDATE AND CONSTITUTION

Forslag til vedtak:

The International Committee approves the proposed new mandate and constitution. The proposal will be sent to the Rector for final approval.

Sammendrag

In the Autumn 2022, an evaluation of the International Committee resulted in a revision of the International Committee's mandate and constitution. The existing mandate and constitution has been discussed in both the International Committee and local International Committees, and revised in line with comments and inputs from all Faculties, the Director of Academic and Student Affairs, Prorektor Education, the International Office and the International Committee.

The International Committee shall decide and agree on the final proposal for a new mandate and constitution in the Committee meeting 8th of June 2023. Once the International Committee has agreed on the proposal, it will be sent to Rector for approval.

The International Committee will operate under a new mandate and constitution from autumn 2023.

Saksframstilling

Mandate

The International Committee at Nord University has an important function to stimulate internationalization activities at Faculty and amongst students, and to build a strong culture for internationalization within the institution. The Committee shall foster and ensure that Nord is at the forefront of internationalization in education and research.

1. The International Committee is an advisory board for Nord University's management in all matters pertaining to internationalization in education and research
2. The International Committee can establish and implement measures that stimulate to the realization of Nord's strategic objectives on internationalization
3. The International Committee shall support the Faculties in implemented, ongoing and future activities that contributes to increased quality in education and research through internationalization
4. The International Committee shall advise Nord University's management in the allocation of strategic funding for internationalization, and follow up how strategic funding is used at the Faculty level
5. The International Committee is eligible to propose decisions for Nord University's management when at least half of the constituted members/deputy members are present

Constitution

The International Committee is currently constituted by students and international coordinators. Questions have been raised as to whether this constitution enables academic-strategic assessment and actions, and if the synergy between education and research is ensured. In addition, academic representation in the Committee has been suggested several times as a way to secure academic engagement for internationalization.

Based on this, the following new constitution for the academic year 2023/2024 is proposed:

It is also beneficial to have observers from the Division for Research and Development (AFU), and the International Office present in the Committee meetings.

The Committee is aware that it might be challenging to recruit Vice Deans into the Committee due to hectic schedules. However, as internationalization at faculty level ultimately is the Dean's responsibility, having a Vice Dean for Education as member of the Committee is a strategically important proposal.

With reference to the challenge of recruiting the Vice Deans into the Committee, a rotation each academic year is proposed.

Although this will result in a change of the constitution each academic year, it should be a predictable rotation that enables each Faculty to decide on its member well in advance. The Committee propose to use the above proposed list as reference point for rotation; each academic year, the roles representing the Faculties will move down the list. Meaning that for the academic year 2024/2025, The Vice Dean for Education will represent Faculty of Social Sciences and so on.

INSTITUTIONAL RANKING CRITERIA FOR INCOMING AND OUTGOING STUDENT MOBILITY

Forslag til vedtak:

The International Committee agrees on the following:

1. The working group shall continue working on the draft and include staff from the Admissions office.
2. A final draft shall be sent out to all faculties for input by 1st of August
3. The institutional ranking criteria shall be completed and decided on by 1st of September 2023

Sammendrag

Several of Nord University's exchange agreements have limitations in term of the number of students on exchange per semester/year. Some of Nord's semester packages for incoming students have limitations as well, in term of the number of available spots.

This presents a need to implement institutional ranking criteria that enables a prioritization of students in any case there is competition for the same exchange destination/semester package.

In January 2023, a working group was established with the following task:

- Look at existing ranking criteria and practice implemented locally
- Develop ranking criteria for outgoing and incoming student mobility
- Develop necessary routine- and process descriptions
- Contribute to completion of a Rectors decision

Saksframstilling

Bakgrunn

The working group consisted of international coordinators from HHN, FLU and FSV, in addition to three staff members at the International Office. The group was later expanded to include all faculties and one member representing the incoming team at the International Office.

The working group has discussed existing criteria and the qualification requirements, looked at the Erasmus+ definition for "students with fewer opportunities", and what potential challenges related to competition for exchange/admission to Nord, can be expected to look like. This has resulted in the following drafted criteria:

Ranking criteria for outgoing student mobility from Nord University

1. Weighted grade average and study progression
2. Students are required to have a minimum level of B2 (CEFR) for all courses offered to exchange or equivalent IELTS/TOEFL score
3. 2nd Cycle students shall be prioritized over 1st cycle students in situations where there is competition for the same exchange
4. Students with fewer opportunities shall be prioritized if all other criteria are fulfilled.
Students with fewer opportunities are defined as;
 - * students supporting minors under 18 years
 - * students with refugee status
 - * students with disabilities and chronic health conditions

Ranking criteria for incoming student mobility to Nord University

1. The student must have passed their first year of study (1st cycle students)
2. Students are required to have a minimum level of B2 English (CEFR) or equivalent IELTS/TOEFL score in order to be admitted to English courses offered at Nord University. Scandinavian-speaking students may take Norwegian courses if they can document sufficient level through Erasmus+ OLS test.
3. Students with fewer opportunities shall be prioritized if all other criteria are fulfilled. Students with fewer opportunities are defined as;
 - * students supporting minors under 18 years
 - * students with refugee status
 - * students with disabilities and chronic health conditions

The criteria are meant to be additional to the existing criteria that students must have passed 60 ECTS before going on exchange, as this alone does not provide any basis for processing applications for exchange in any case there is competition.

However, the working group has received feedback that should be taken into consideration;

- Only students who have met the technical requirements can be ranked
- Those who do not meet the requirements, receive a rejection or is routed to alternative destinations with other language requirements – as long as the requirement of 60 ECTS is met
- Language requirements cannot be part of the ranking system, as they have to be met in order to be nominated
- It is necessary to elaborate on criteria number 3 for outgoing student exchange in order to describe why 2nd level students are prioritized over 1st level students
- Regarding fewer opportunities, this needs to be checked with admission office or legal team as to the grounds on which we base this type of ranking in the first place
- Confirm with Admission office that only students from Scandinavian countries can apply to courses taught in Norwegian

On the basis of this, the working group should continue its work to draft up institutional ranking criteria. The working group should also include a staff member from the Admissions office to ensure the ranking criteria are aligned with, and not overlapping, the admission requirements. A new draft should be sent out to relevant units at Nord University no later than 1st of August, and the final draft should be completed by 1st of September 2023.

Bakgrunn

SEA-EU is a European university alliance that aims to strengthen cooperation in education and research across national borders in Europe. Nord University officially joined the alliance in the beginning of 2023. The SEA-EU gives Nord University a unique possibility to establish collaboration with relevant partners within research, innovation, education and other areas that contribute to development for the university and our subject areas.

Nord University encourage all staff to establish collaboration with relevant partners within research, innovation, education and other areas that contribute to development for the university and the work-packages in the SEA-EU alliance.

Relevant information and a status report on the SEA-EU projects will be given at all meetings in the International Committee in the years to come.

Drøfting

Sammendrag

Through the Bologna Process, Norway committed to 20% outgoing student mobility by 2020. In Whitepaper nr. 7, “A world of opportunities – international student mobility within higher education”, the objective was for the Government to contribute to a cultural change within Norwegian Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to make internationalization an integrated part of all study programs. This is meant to enable Norwegian HEIs to reach the Government’s long term ambition of 50% student mobility.

Nord University is, through Strategy 2030 and the Action Plan for Education 2021-2025, and now also the SEA-EU Alliance, committed to strengthen internationalization in education and research. Although internationalization is much more than student mobility, it is a crucial part of internationalization. It is also one of the tasks that Nord University has committed to deliver on in SEA-EU.

Historically, Nord University’s mobility numbers are nowhere near 20 or 50%, and it is therefore necessary to make strategic actions to improve student mobility to and from Nord University.

Student exchange to Nord University Autumn 2023

We received 171 nominations (147 in «nettskjema» and 24 in the pilot project in Nominasjonsweb) within the deadline on April 1st. This is an increase from last year when we received 138 nominations. In 2021 we received 121.

All numbers presented are extracted from FS report 101.001 *Søkerliste* and is only for the Autumn intake.

The International Office sent out offers of admission to 131 exchange students in the weeks after the deadline of April 15th.

As we can see the numbers for 2023 is a lot lower than in 2022. We believe this is due to the implementing of tuition fees for students from countries outside the EU/EEA/Swiss area. Currently (31.05.23) there is only 7 students who have applied to use the Nord University holding account to document sufficient funding to the UDI, but this number might change in the following weeks.

A more detailed presentation of what study programs and faculty these students have applied to is attached to this case.

The results of the EU admission to our degree programs are not yet ready. These numbers will be presented in the September meeting.

EVALUATION OF THE PILOT IN "NOMINASJONSWEB" AND "SØKNADSWEB"

Forslag til vedtak:

The International Committee take note of the orientation.

Sammendrag

Nord University will implement a new application system for incoming and outgoing exchange starting autumn 2023. In light of this, there have been pilots for both through the application system Søknadsweb to test the system out before full implementation.

Saksframstilling

In December we ran a pilot for outgoing student mobility. We tried to get students from each faculty to send an application through the system. While student participation was relatively low, the students who did participate found the process smooth and did not experience problems. The pilot highlighted some issues that ultimately made us decide to postpone the implementation of the system. These issues were in large due to agreements. Many agreements were not renewed which would limit the students possibilities when applying in the system. Additionally, there were no ranking criteria in place at that time.

The pilot for nomination ran parallel with the manual admission of exchange students (February 15th-april 15th). 15 partners were invited to participate. 25 students were nominated and 24 applied. There were few questions from partners regarding the process, suggesting that most found it relatively easy.

This pilot also highlighted some issues, mainly regarding how flexible we have been in the past. The system will limit flexibility both in terms of nominating to Nord and for outgoing students from Nord when a faculty is not part of the agreement. It also highlighted the need for faculties to familiarize themselves with FS and do a thorough check of their entire partner portfolio before full implementation.

Drøfting

As of today, Efi is sending out admission letters to the exchange students and the faculty coordinators are sending out rejection letters. It was suggested during the work meeting on the 24th of April that both letters should come from the central administration.

All faculties are asked to give comments on the case and the pilot projects.

- På Steinkjer kan man lage arrangement sammen med FBA og involvere flere av bedriftene på InnoCamp som Nibio og Sintef. Studentrepresentant Pål Inge kan dele sin erfaring av sommerskole som han skal delta på sommeren 2023.
- Bodø2024 kan delta på International Week der de kan/skal ha et panel for representanter av forskjellige kulturer.
- Et speed dating arrangement med Nord studenter og innreisende utvekslingsstudenter.
- Speed dating med SEA-EU partnere for International Week i 2024. Det kan være en av flere plattformer for å bli bedre kjent med dem.
- Samarbeid mellom universitetet og kommuner. Noen arrangement kan være på universitetet mens andre kan være i andre lokaler i sentrum, gjelder spesielt for de studiestedene der campus ikke er midt i sentrum.
- Finne måter å invitere samfunnet rundt universitetet og studiestedene til å delta for å feire internasjonalisering. En dag denne uken kan fokusere på internasjonalisering sammen med menneskene som bor i nærmiljøene til universitetet.

3/2023 Vedtakssak: Handlingsplan 2023 – fokusområder for våren

Saksfremstilling:

Utvalget diskuterte og vurderte hvilke områder som er viktigst å fokusere på gjennom vårsemesteret 2023 og hvilke tiltak som må gjennomføres.

Innen fokusområdet internasjonal profil skal det jobbes videre med å videreutvikle vårt engelske emnetilbud. Arbeidsgruppen som jobber med å utarbeide semesterpakken ved Steinkjer skal fortsette med arbeidet i vårsemesteret 2023. Det ble stilt spørsmål om hvordan vi kan inkludere ansatte som er interessert i være involvert i SEA-EU når de selv ikke vet hvem de skal kontakte. Det ble kommentert at HHN må passe på alle mulighetene som også ligger utenfor universitetsalliansen. Det er viktig at vi ikke blir fullstendig oppslukt av den og vi også sørger for å ivareta andre muligheter.

Det skal være fokus på utreisende studenter og hvordan fakultetet som helhet kan jobbe bedre for å oppfordre studenter til å reise på forskjellige former for utveksling. Det kom forslag om å bruke Canvas mer. Man kan legge inn arrangement i kalenderen der og forelesere kan legge inn

påminnelser om utveksling, for eksempel når man ønsker studentene en god juleferie så kan man også skrive to setninger der man minner dem på hvor de kan tilbringe neste høstsemester. Forelesere kan også være frampå og gi spesifikke anbefalinger til studentene om hvor de bør dra men det bør koordineres med internasjonal rådgiver for kvalitetssikring. Studentene ønsker gjerne at informasjon om utveksling bør komme i oktober men ønsker seg flere påminnelser, både til jul men spesielt i januar for utveksling i løpet av høstsemesteret.

Utvalget skal fremdeles involvere ansatte ved å dele god informasjon om ansattmobilitet og hvilke muligheter som ligger tilgjengelig.

4/2023 Orienteringssak: Søkere for utveksling og internship H23/V24

Saksfremstilling:

Utvalget fikk en oppdatering og litt statistikk på antall studenter som har søkt seg på utveksling for høst og vårsemesteret 23/24. Søkermassen er halvert fra fjorårets tall noe som var forventet. Det er likevel langt høyere tall sammenlignet med før pandemien. Det vil være noen ekstra søknadsrunder for kortere utvekslingsopphold som sommerinternship. Det er ofte noen studenter som trekker seg fra utveksling av forskjellige grunner så det skal presenteres oppdaterte tall i juni møtet som også inkluderer destinasjon.

5/2023 Vedtakssak: Rangering av søkere for utveksling

Saksfremstilling:

Flere av Nords utvekslingsavtaler er begrenset på antall plasser. Utvekslingsavtalene kan også brukes av flere studieprogram internt på fakultet, eller av andre Nord studenter. Det er behov for å innføre rangeringskriterier som viser til en prioritering av studenter ved konkurranse om en og samme plass for utreise. Ved innveksling til Nord, så vil enkelte semesterpakker vil kunne ha plassbegrensning på emneopptaket.

Det er satt ned en arbeidsgruppe som skal se på dette. Arbeidsgruppen har vurdert flere forslag til kriterier som kan brukes slik som vektet karaktersnitt, språkferdigheter, annen relevant erfaring og personlig egnethet.

Utvalget var enige om at det er vanskelig å vurdere ut fra personlig egnethet og mener det ikke bør være et kriterium. Det ble også stilt spørsmål om språkferdigheter er et godt grunnlag for vurdering da det kanskje ikke har særlig betydning. Eksempelvis hvis IELTS scoren er 6,0 eller 6,5.

Det ble foreslått at master studenter bør få prioritet over bachelor studenter hvis de søker på samme avtale. Det skyldes at masterstudenter har færre tilgjengelig avtaler som de kan reise på og bachelor studenter vil også ha mulighet til å reise på utveksling dersom de tar en mastergrad. Et annet forslag er å ha vektet kriterier slik at vektet karaktersnitt er 60% og resterende består av eksempelvis språkferdigheter og/eller motivasjonsbrev.

Vedtak:

Representant for administrasjonen vil ta med kommentarene til utvalget videre til arbeidsgruppen som skal utforme rangeringen.

6/2023 Vedtakssak: Prioriteringer for Erasmus+ ansattmobilitet

Saksfremstilling:

Det vil være utlysninger for Erasmus+ ansattmobilitet to ganger i året med faste søknadsfrister 20. januar og 1. august. Den nye rutinen for ansattmobilitet og allokering av budsjettet ble presentert for utvalget i møtet og er beskrevet i innkallelsen. Utvalget ble bedt om å kommentere på hvilke prioriteringer HHN bør gjøre etter at fakultet mottar listen med søkere.

Det var vanskelig å vurdere hva som bør prioriteres og det var også vanskelig å vurdere Erasmus+ training versus teaching som to forskjellige mobilitetstyper. Det er også utfordrende å generalisere da det er individbasert.

Flere spørsmål ble stilt:

- Hvem vil ha mest nytte av å dra på ansattmobilitet? Individet eller organisasjonen?
- Har søkeren andre muligheter for finansiering for internasjonalisering?
- Bør strategiske partnere få høyere prioritering?

De som søker som har andre finansieringsmulighet bør nødvendigvis ikke få høyest prioritet, da det er ansatte som eksempelvis ikke holder på med forskning men kun foreleser og dette er en av få muligheter for å få finansiering og få internasjonal erfaring og bygge nettverk.

Det er viktig å se på det store bildet og helheten. Dersom det er en viktig partner for HHN så bør søknaden være høyere prioritert. Mobiliteten vil ikke kun være personavhengig men også hvordan vi kan bruke erfaringen og andre utfall for HHN som helhet. Dette kan basere seg på hvorvidt partneren er relevant for utveksling eller hvordan vi kan videre bygge på samarbeidet. Merk at med strategiske partnere har vi i flere tilfeller andre former for finansiering gjennom forskjellige prosjekter.
